- * Sunday, May 19 after 7:30 am Mass, SH is hosting a free breakfast for anyone attending Mass. Please stay and join us in fellowship.

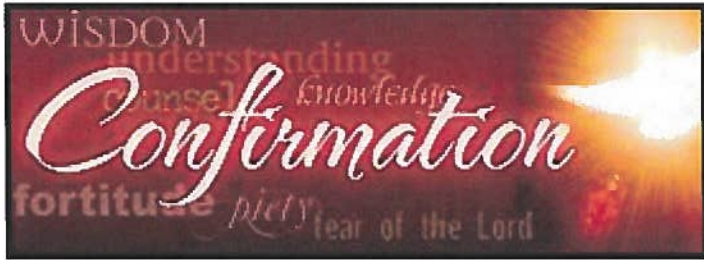
St. James—
