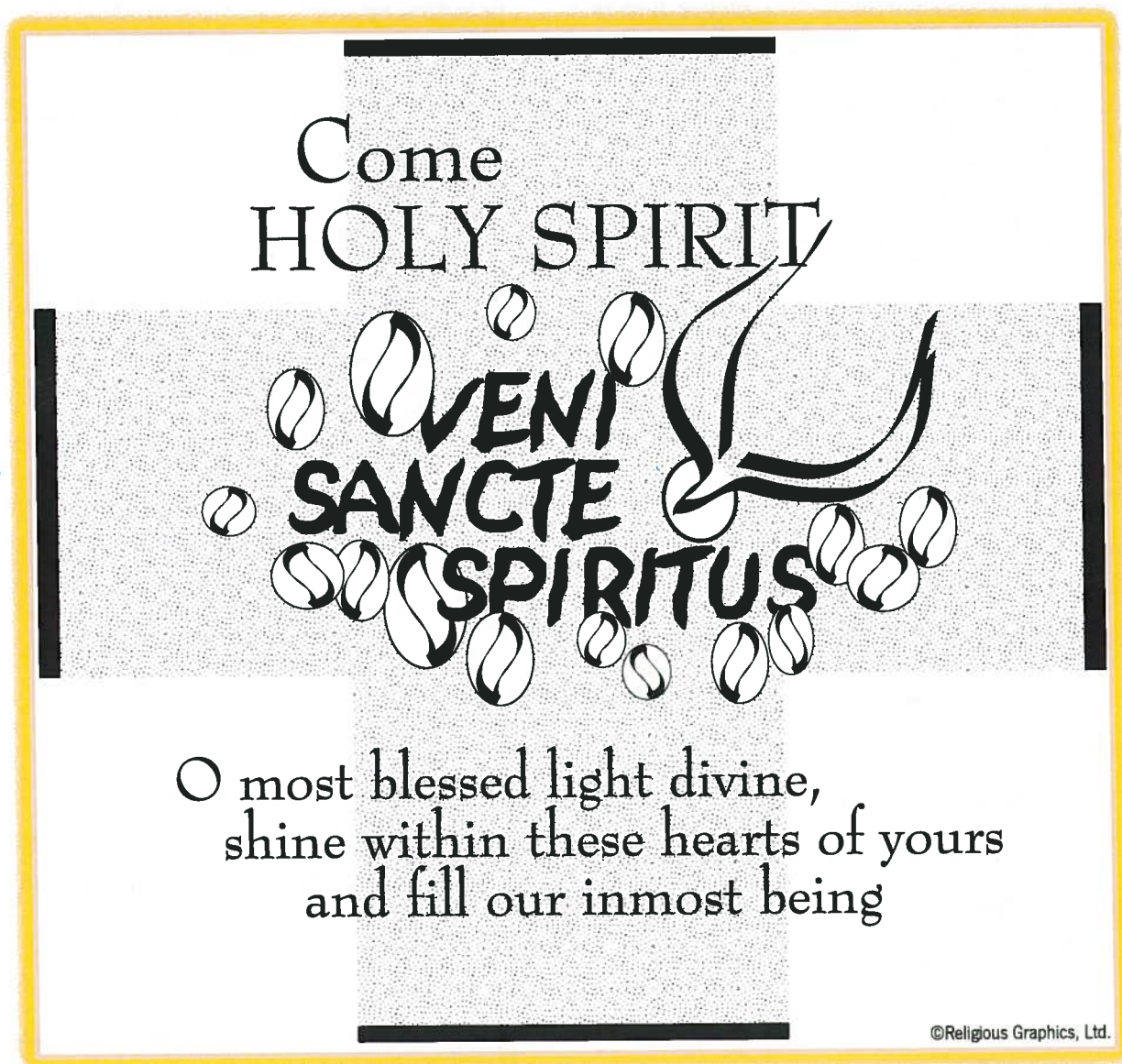

A Stewardship Moment— Pentecost Sunday

In John's Gospel, Jesus appears in the Upper Room on that first Easter night, breathing his Spirit on his Apostles and saying, *Peace be with you*. At that moment, Jesus takes away their fears that His body may have been stolen, and He assures them that He is both risen and glorified. This event also draws our minds back to the Book of Genesis (2:7) where God created Adam. The first man did not have life until God *breathed* his Spirit into his nostrils. In the Upper Room on Mount Zion, the Apostles had long since been charged with the task of preaching and building up God's Kingdom; but they did not have the life-giving capability of fulfilling this mission until Jesus *breathed* His God-given power upon them.
